1.Smoking Cessation Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On the 30th year of successful implementation, the program has helped smokers remain tobacco- free after quitting smoking in 3 ways: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> > Face - to - Face counselling at the LCP clinic; > Via the Quitline Program; and > On-line over the official Facebook Page of LCP “Bawal Mag-Yosi” • Won the prestigious Red Orchid Hall of Fame award in 2017. • Trained Smoking Cessation Specialists on call handling, nicotine addiction and smoking cessation. • Subscribed and launched tool-free 1558 on June 25, 2021. • Promoted the program and services through social media, radio / TV programs, partnership with medical associations, government agencies, Academe local government units, commercial establishments, medical outreach programs and telemarketing.

4. Lung Cancer Early Detection Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Implementation has already been started with the following documents developed. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Protocol and Algorithm Phase I ➤ Eligibility Questionnaire and Forms. ➤ Revised the Program, Protocol, SOPs, Algorithm and Process Flow ➤ Trained LCP radiologists for Lung Rads VI.1 Interpretation.
5. COPD Support Group Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On the 28th year of implementation, it has now a total of 423 members at the end of 2020 from 372 in 2013. • Participated in the “Minute to Win It COPD Olympics” in celebration of the World COPD Day in December 2018. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 123 batches conducted ➤ Participated in the Virtual COPD Olympics 2020 held on Nov. 21, 2020 in celebration of the World COPD Day. The LCP group won as the Champion. ➤ No regular assembly and face-to-face program conducted due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
6. Bronchiectasis Support Group Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On the 9th year of implementation, it has now a total of 72 members at the end of 2020 from only 3 in 2013. • Together with the COPD Support Group, it has also participated in the celebration of the World COPD Day in November 2020. • 26 batches conducted.
