

### C. THE STATUS OF IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SAID PROGRAMS 2020

PROGRAM	STATUS OF IMPLEMENTATION
1. Smoking Cessation Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• On the 29<sup>th</sup> year of successful implementation, the program has helped smokers remain tobacco-free after quitting smoking in 3 ways:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Face-to-Face counselling at the LCP clinic;</li> <li>➤ Via the Quitline Program; and</li> <li>➤ On-line over the official Facebook Page of LCP “Bawal Mag-Yosi.”</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Won the prestigious Red Orchid Hall of Fame award in 2017</li> </ul>
2. Quitline Program.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• As of February 2020, it has received 1298 calls and made 5163 follow-up calls.</li> <li>• 406 enrolled in the program</li> <li>• 92 are currently engaged in the program.</li> <li>• 64 are tobacco free</li> <li>• 13 have quit smoking in less than 6 months.</li> <li>• Continuous collaboration with the different sectors of society and the private organizations.</li> </ul>
3. Anti-Air Pollution Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Program has temporarily been stopped pending availability of funds but negotiations for this are still being pursued.</li> <li>• Some of its activities have been consolidated into the Healthy Lung Programs.</li> </ul>

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4. Lung Cancer Early Detection Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Implementation has already been started with the following documents developed: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Protocol and Algorithm Phase I</li> <li>➤ Eligibility Questionnaire and Forms.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
5. COPD Support Group Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• On the 27<sup>th</sup> year of implementation, it has now a total of 416 members at the end of 2019 from 372 in 2013.</li> <li>• Participated in the “Minute to Win It COPD Olympics” in celebration of the World COPD Day in December 2018.</li> </ul>
6. Bronchiectasis Support Group Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• On the 8<sup>th</sup> year of implementation, it has now a total of 72 members at the end of 2019 from only 3 in 2013.</li> <li>• Together with the COPD Support Group, it has also participated in the celebration of the World COPD Day in December 2018.</li> </ul>
7. LCP Wellness Gym (Fats-Loss Program)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• On the 8<sup>th</sup> year of implementation, there is now a total of 496 enrollees who have availed of the program at the end of 2019.</li> <li>• 2,432 clients have utilized the wellness gym in 2019.</li> </ul>
8. Comprehensive Asthma Clinic	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• On the 29<sup>th</sup> year of implementation the program has conducted the following training courses: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Asthma Refreshers' course for Asthma Club members</li> <li>➤ Three Batches of Asthma Seminars for Asthma Club members</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Conducted two batches of Asthma General Assemblies for Patients</li> <li>• Celebrated the world Asthma Day.</li> </ul>

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9. Hospice and Palliative Care Center (HPCC)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Full swing of implementation commenced in the last quarter of 2018.</li> <li>• Formalized the Palliative Care Core Team.</li> <li>• Updated the Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs).</li> <li>• Formulated its Referral and Action forms.</li> <li>• Celebrated the Palliative Care Month in October.</li> <li>• Conducted the following training and seminar workshops: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Palliative Core Team Training</li> <li>➤ Palliative Care for LCP Nurses</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Management of Dyspnea</li> </ul>
10. Pain Management Clinic	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• On the 20<sup>th</sup> year of implementation, the program has been offering the following services: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Individualized Treatment Plans in the form of oral medications, injections, nerve blocks, physical therapy, psychological support and counseling, acupuncture and surgery;</li> <li>➤ Symposia.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
11. Critical airway and Interventional Pulmonary Unit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Initial stage of full implementation has already been carried out.</li> </ul>
12. Esophagus and Swallowing Center	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Monthly Organizational meetings conducted by members of the Program Committee.</li> <li>• Formulated plans, policies, standard operating procedures for the Program Implementation.</li> </ul>

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13. Healthy Lung Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Conducted 8 batches of seminar workshops.</li> <li>• Conducted 4 sessions of community outreach activities</li> <li>• Conducted 9 batches of organizational meetings.</li> </ul>
14.
